

FRIENDS OF SNA-VA AWARD

The Friends of SNA-VA Award is to be given to someone, outside of school nutrition programs, who has done extraordinary work on behalf of school nutrition programs. A letter of nomination citing specific examples of work done on behalf of school nutrition programs should be submitted. Examples of nominees could be a local or state person who has championed child nutrition programs, through positive advocacy or through the political process. The award may not be given each year.

Winner will receive a framed certificate and invitation to the general session (paid meal) when award is given.

ADMINISTRATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

This Award is presented to a supervisory level (not director) person who meets the following criteria:

- ❖ Employed in school nutrition at least 5 years
- ❖ Active membership in SNA, SNA-VA and local chapter if there is one-provide membership number
- ❖ Certified or credentialed by SNA
- ❖ Demonstrated leadership in the field in one of more areas that may include marketing, nutrition education, finance, human resources.

A letter of nomination citing specific examples of accomplishments in areas listed plus an endorsement by the district director (director may write the nomination as well).

SNA-VA LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Eligible: All SNA-VA members (living or deceased)

Criteria:

- ❖ Demonstrated exceptional achievements in the area of Child Nutrition issues in schools, community, state, nationally and in legislation.
- ❖ 25 + years of experience.
- ❖ SNA Certified or Credentialed

Winner will be presented with an engraved plaque at State Conference.
